


#### **Example 1: How to Access Table B19001 for Memphis, TN**



**Step 1:** From the free form search box, type Table B19001 Memphis, TN. Click Search.


**Step 2:** Click the first table that appears in the search results, B19001.

#### Step 3: After the click the full table appears, Table B19001 for Memphis, TN.






## Example 2: Use the Advanced Search to Find: Education and Earnings for Oklahoma, Oklahoma City, and Oklahoma County




**Step 1:** Click the Advanced Search button. Advanced Search allows you to select search criteria in a step-by-step filtering experience where you select desired checkboxes.

#### **Step 2:** Click "Topics" at FILTERS → Click "Education" at TOPICS → Check the box next to "Education."




### Example 2: Use the Advanced Search to Find: Education and Earnings for Oklahoma, Oklahoma City, and Oklahoma County (cont.)


#### Step 4: Click "Geography" at FILTERS → Click "State" at GEOGRAPHY → Check the box next to "Oklahoma."






## Example 2: Use the Advanced Search to Find: Education and Earnings for Oklahoma, Oklahoma City, and Oklahoma County (cont.)





**Step 7:** After the click, the table results appear.






Step 8: Scroll down to view the map results.






Step 1: From the free form search box, type "commuting all counties Kansas" and click Search.




Step 2: After the results appear, click the MAPS tab.




#### Step 4: Select "Mean Travel time to work (minutes) – Estimate" the Data Variable drop-down list






**Step 5:** Once the Data Variable is selected, the map displays "Mean Travel time to work (minutes) – Estimate" for all counties in Kansas.




**Step 6:** To download data from the map, click Download.

Step 8: Click Download Selected to continue the Download process.




Step 9: Check the box for Vintage 2017, and click Download.


**Step 10:** Click **Download** Now.









### **Step 12:** Select where you would like to unzip the file.
